


## Connecting radios all over the world

### How to hide a device from SoftRadio


In some setups of Mimer SoftRadio you have devices that you need in the system but have no need to show to the operator. For example when having an interface that is not used for voice, for example DSC or NDB. It needs to run in the background but since you normally only operate it from the Marine Calls Panel or from the Custom Functions Panel, there is no need to show it on SoftRadio.



You need to run the larger version of SoftRadio called “SoftRadio XL”.

- Set up all you devices, including the one that will be hidden, as usual in Mimer Connection Setup.
- In Operator Settings, tick in the box “Allow users to select connections”.
- Under Settings in SoftRadio tick the box “Group Device Panels into Tabs”.
- You only need to have one tab. You can name it for example “Marine Radio”.
- Go into “Select Devices” in SoftRadio and set all radios as Active. Then untick the device that shall be hidden from the list of devices on your tab.

The device will now be active in the background.
