+12VDC / max 0,3A.




Jotron TR810 installed together with a MotoTrbo radio and the X-Link interface on a rack shelf.

Settings in the X-Link interface

Select the proper settings for Radio A or Radio B depending on your connection.

- Radio with AF level sense for Rx detect.
- Set the detect level etc.
 Details can be found in the set up manual.

The levels in the picture are our recommendations. You might find that your radio needs adjustments.

Check/adjust the audio levels in both directions in the interface so that the users hears the X-Link with the same level as when listening to other radios.




